22/01 The meeting was opened by the Chair at 19.30 hours.

22/02 Apologies for Absence
Apologies were received from Cllr P Waters and Cllr M Broadley

22/03 Declarations of Interests
No declarations were received.

22/04 Minutes of the Previous Meeting
The minutes of the meeting held on 17th November 2021 were approved by all those who were present and signed by the chair.

22/05 Matters Arising
There were no matters arising.

22/06 Planning Applications
Two planning application were received: 21/01232/FUL approval to erect a four bedroom detached dwelling with attached single garage/utility/store together with formation of vehicular access on land to the south of Cottage Farm, Main Street, Foxholes.
21/01245/FUL approval for change of use and extension to former chapel to form a five bedroom dwelling to include formation of a mezzanine floor, erection of a single story extension to south elevation, formation of vehicular access and construction of single garage with landscape works at, Foxholes Methodist Church, Main Street, Foxholes.

22/07 Mower
It was agreed that the mower would be sold for its current market value. Cllr S Hartle agreed to speak to A Scruton to see if he wished to purchase it. It was also agreed to pay the unexpected repair invoice received.

22/08 Street Lights
A quotation £2100 + VAT was received from NYCC for the cost of replacing the lights. Following discussion it was agreed that the street lights in Foxholes and Butterwick would be replaced with modern LED bulbs. The timing of the work was dependant on

the financial position which was to be discussed further at the next meeting.

22/09 Accounts to Pay

The following accounts were presented for payment: Autela Payroll Services £31.07 and W Scruton (Mower Repairs) £277.88 which were approved by all.

22/10 Correspondence

22/11 Other Business

A resident in Butter suggest the purchase of a planter in celebration of the Queen Jubilee. It was agreed that funding would be sought from NYCC which the parish council would top up to cover the cost.

Roadside litter in the pull-ins on the road from Butterwick heading towards Foxholes has been reported to RDC for cleaning up.

A tree has fallen down near the pond which has now been cut up by Cllr C Tomlin.

It was notes that the trees in Pump Lane have been cut back, however debris has been left all over the footpath.

The badly potholes edges of the road between Foxholes and Wold Newton were still awaiting action by NYCC.
